"Two Unusual Genera for the Beginning Orchid Grower, the Maxillarias and Catasetums"

We are pleased to have Doug Overstreet as our July speaker. Doug was born and raised in New Mexico and currently resides in Glendale. The son a floral designer and descendant on both sides from a long line of farmers, he comes by his interest in orchids naturally. He began growing orchids at the age of twelve and has been avidly involved in the hobby ever since. He currently maintains a mixed collection of approximately 1000 plants. A frequent lecturer on orchids and related topics, Doug has spoken for numerous orchid societies, botanical gardens and orchid nurseries. He is noted for his ability to present complex information on orchids clearly, concisely and in a manner suitable for the advanced enthusiast and yet easily understandable by the absolute beginner. Doug has written a year long series of articles on Integrated Pest Management for the Orchid House for The Orchid Digest magazine and is also a member of its editorial board. He is a Certified Probationary Judge in the AOS. A gifted orchid educator and lively speaker, you will not want to miss his talk on these two unusual genera.

This incredibly floriferous plant readily produces basal keikis but its crowning glory is its compact branching flower spikes displaying multitudes of 2inch (5-cm) golden vellow flowers heavily overlaid centrally with a rich deep rose to produce flowers that appear to almost glow. 
