# Orchid Digest "40 Species for your Greenhouse"

We will be watching a slideshow from Orchid Digest titled "40 Species for your Greenhouse". The slideshow was based on recommendations by Red and Trudi Marsh from orchids in their own collection. Images of the orchids were kindly supplied by Eric Hunt, Greg Allikas, and other AOS award photographers with additional information from Jay Pfahl of the Internet Orchid Species Photo Encyclopedia. The Marshes were fortunate to be able to go to Brazil with Dr. Jack Fowlie to do some collecting. This started a whole new concept—growing species, which added a new dimension to their orchids and their lives. One of the things the Marshes enjoyed the most about collecting species was the variation in blooming times. "There is always something in bloom in our greenhouse and always others in bud about ready to open. The Marshes either purchased or traded for most of their plants and had them growing in the intermediate house. They were all favorites of the Marshes. They always said that the ones in bloom at the moment were the best.


