George is active in both the Cymbidium Society of America (CSA) and the American Orchid Society (AOS), as well as several Southern California regional organizations for orchids.

He is an orchid judge for both the CSA and AOS. He is past president of the CSA and was the Chairman of the CSA Cymbidium Congress from 1998-2001 and president of the Santa Barbara International Orchid Show in 2002 & 2003.

Currently George is Chair of the Pacific South Judging Region, AOS, and Vice President of the Santa Barbara International Orchid Show.

George was the Key Note Speaker at the 2009 Australian National Orchid Conference in Melbourne.
