AMERICAN ORCHID SOCIETY WEBINAR DOCTOR, DOCTOR, I SEE SPOTS!

Webinars are online video presentations. You can register for an upcoming webinar or watch the recorded webinars any time at your convenience. We add multiple webinars each month, so check back often. Some webinars you need to be a member of the AOS and some are open to the public at no cost.

Please join us at our next meet to hear Andrew Coghill-Behrends as he presents a discussion on *Cattleya guttata* and its hybrids.

Cattleya guttata is a medium sized, cool to warm growing epiphyte or lithophyte from near the seashore in southern Brazil with cylindrical, elongate pseudobulbs carrying 2 apical, spreading, elliptic-oblong, very coriaceous leaves and the inflorescence arises on a fully matured pseudobulb in the fall and winter on a terminal, to 1 1/2' [45 cm] long, few to several flowered inflorescence subtended by a broad dried sheath and giving rise to heavy textured, waxy, fragrant flowers that can be long or short lived.

This species needs a distinct dry winter rest which in turn will bring about blooming.

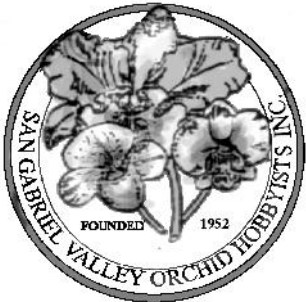
