Jim Henrich received his BA degree in biology and chemistry from the University of Minnesota, Morris in 1976 and an MS degree in horticulture studying Intergeneric Incompatibility in the Iridaceae from the University of Minnesota, St. Paul in 1979. He continued his postgraduate coursework in biology with emphasis in plant systematics at Saint Louis University and conducted research on the Phylogeny of the New World Iridaceae (excluding the genus *Iris*) at Missouri Botanical Garden.

While at Missouri Botanical Garden from 1979-1992, he worked in the research department as Coordinator of the Flora de Nicaragua. He also held several positions in the horticulture department including acting director of Horticulture.

From 1992-1999 he was the director of horticulture at Denver Botanic Gardens where he worked with many teams within the botanical gardens as well as with disparate groups of people from the community. Two significant programs created while at DBG were Plant Select (a plant promotion and introduction program) and Planttalk Colorado (a free, horticultural information service accessible by telephone and the web).

From 2001-2006 he was responsible for overseeing the day-to-day horticultural and related construction activities associated with the rehabilitation of the 1879 wood-and-glass Conservatory of flowers in San Francisco. Concurrently he manages several project at the San Francisco Botanical Gardens at Strybing Arboretum. At present, Jim is the curator of living collection at the Los Angeles County Arboretum & Botanic Garden.

During 2007-2008 he spent 5 months working at Nectandra Cloud Forest Garden at La Balsa, Costa Rica, studying bryophytes that comprise the living epiphytic layer that blankets the trees in the forest.

His plant interests are wide ranging with emphasis on geophytes and orchids, as well as, the uncommon, unusual and bizarre.


